

MARKET SWEEP!



A PICTURE LOTTO GAME ALL ABOUT TASTY, HEALTHY FOOD

Play the game where children learn where we go to buy our food! The six game boards represent different shop fronts; each features illustrations of the different foods available. By contrast, the picture card tokens they must match appear as photographs. This is done to make sure players do more than merely match identical pictures: as they learn to match the illustrations and the photographs, they'll also learn to recognise foods.

SET UP

Carefully pop out all the card tokens and each player chooses a game board or shop front. If only 2 players are taking part, each can play with up to 3 gameboards.



HOW TO PLAY 'MARKET SWEEP'

REQUIRED BUT NOT INCLUDED: A PLASTIC OR CANVAS BAG

Shuffle the card tokens and drop them into a plastic or canvas bag. The youngest player dips into the bag first and draws out a card token. If that's you then check and see if it belongs on your game board (or one of the game boards left over on the table). If it does then place the card token over the matching space. You can use the picture to match items, or the word on the other side of the token will also match the word on your game board. The next player to the left takes a turn, dipping into the bag for the next card token. Play continues with everyone taking turns until one player is first to complete his or her own game board. That player wins the game, and gets to wear a Grow with Jumbo sticker as a reward!
