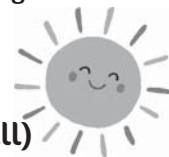


GAME 5 Lotto game with colours

- Place the colour discs in a pile.
- The youngest player takes the top disc from the pile and places it on a picture with the same colour on one of his boards.
- If he has already placed a disc with that colour on his board, he puts the disc back at the bottom of the pile.
- Then it's the next player's turn.
- The first player to fill his board or boards wins.

Alternative: instead of placing the discs in a pile, you can lay them face down on the table. This turns the game into a memory lotto game.

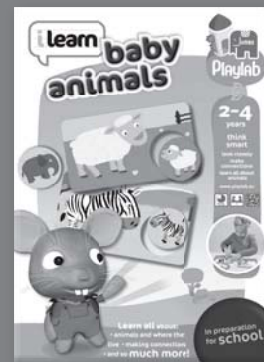


GAME 6 Rapido colours (game of skill)

- The picture discs are placed on the table with the picture facing up.
- The colour discs are placed face down and form 'the pot'.
- The youngest player takes a colour disc from the pot and says something like "Red like..."
- The first player to find a shape disc in that colour picks it up and says: "Red like cherries!"
- He turns the disc over and, if it has the same colour, he wins both discs.
- Then it is the next player's turn.
- The game ends when there are no more colour discs in the pot: the player with the most discs wins.

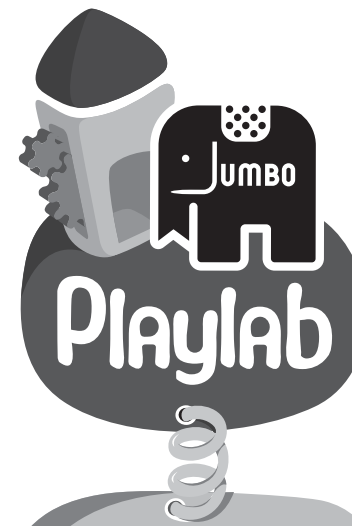

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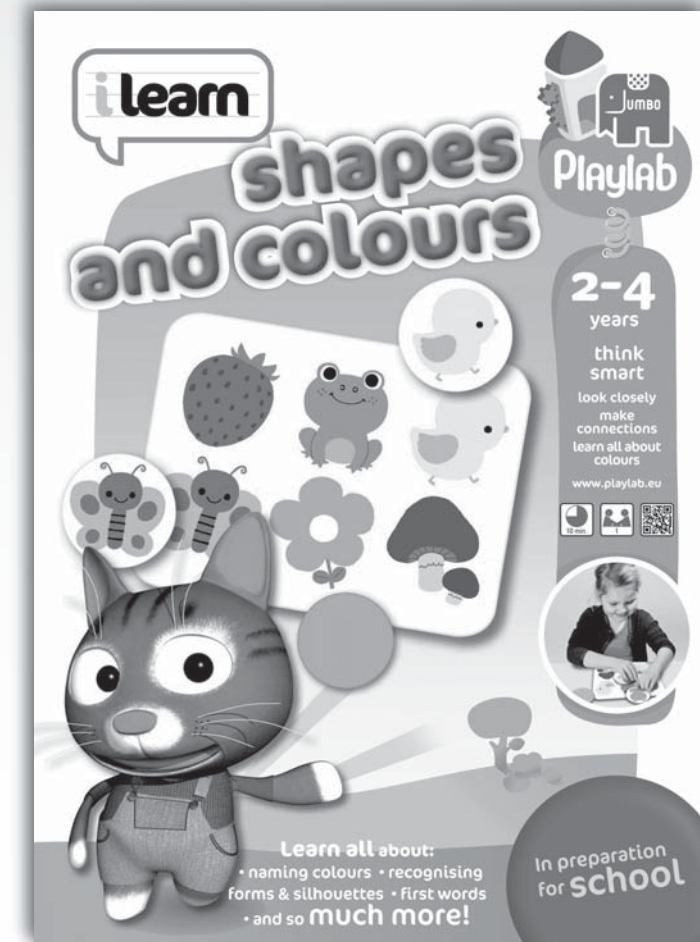
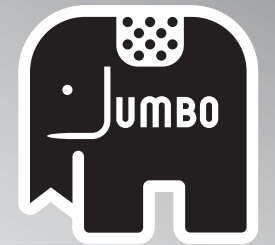
Jumbo Playlab

UK Game Rules

Shapes and colours

- 4 boards:
 - on the front: 6 pictures in different colours
 - on the back: 6 pictures in silhouette
- 24 discs with a colour picture on the front and a picture in silhouette on the back
- 24 colour discs

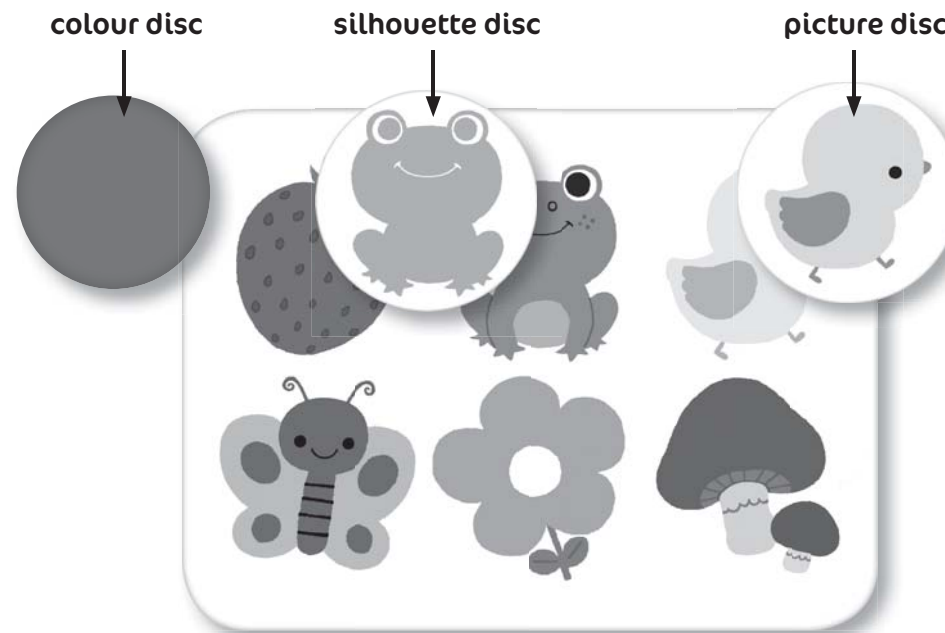

For parents

Around the age of 2, your child starts to discover and recognise colours. The 'Ilearn...' series helps this process with fun, development-oriented games with clear aims:

- 1 Learn to name colours
- 2 Increase vocabulary
- 3 Recognise shapes and silhouettes



The games become more challenging as your child's skills increase. It is recommended that children begin with Game 1.

To play alone

GAME 1 Picture game

- Choose a board and the accompanying coloured picture discs.
- The child chooses one of the discs and names the picture.
- He finds the accompanying picture on the board and places the disc.
- As your child gets better at this game you can play with two or more boards

GAME 2 Colour game

- The child chooses a board and places it in front of him with the coloured side facing up.
- Pick up a colour disc and ask something like:
 - "Who is blue?"
 - "The whale is blue!"
- The child is given a disc and places it on the picture he has named.
- When the board is full, he chooses another board.

Extending the game:

- You can also have your child sort all the colour discs: all the red discs together, all the yellow discs, etc.
- Play with your child by helping him discover other things that are red: "the tomatoes! the fire engine! my shoes!"

GAME 3 Silhouette game

- The child chooses a board and places it in front of him with the silhouettes facing up.
- Take a picture disc with a silhouette, show it to your child and ask something like:
 - "Who am I?"
 - "You're the frog!"
- The child is given the disc and places it on the picture he has named.
- When the board is full, he chooses another board.



Playing together:

- If there are 4 players, each player gets 1 board.
 - If there are 3 players, each player gets 1 board. (1 board and the accompanying discs are removed from the game.)
 - If there are 2 players, each player gets 2 boards. The players place their boards in front of them with the coloured side facing up.

GAME 4 Lotto game with pictures

- Place the picture discs face down in a pile.
- The youngest player takes the top disc from the pile and looks to see if he has the same picture on one of his boards.
 - If he finds the picture, he places the disc on it with the coloured side facing up.
 - If he does not find the picture, he places the disc back at the bottom of the pile and the next player takes his turn.
 - The first player to fill his board or boards wins.
